



# Hospital Admission

## Checklist

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### Preparation

- How are you insured (general, private, semi-private ward)?
  - Do you have a health or accident daily allowance insurance? Have you informed the provider of these about the planned hospital stay?
  - Enquiry to family doctor: Have the preliminary exam results already been sent to the hospital?
  - Who cares for your children during and after the hospital stay?
  - Who takes care of the pet, plants, mail and bills while you are away?
  - How do you get to the hospital on the day of admission?
  - Do you need to stop taking certain medications prior to entering the hospital?
  - Is special preparation necessary before entering the hospital (e. g. colon cleansing)?
  - Are you allowed to eat and drink on the day of admission?
  - How do you get home after your stay in hospital?
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### Documents and records

- Identity card
  - Health insurance card
  - Possible reports of attending doctors
  - Current medication in original packaging, or medicine plan
  - If applicable: medication pass (e. g. blood thinning)
  - If applicable: allergy passport
  - If applicable: other specific treatment cards (e. g. prosthesis passport, implants, cardiac pacemaker)
  - Names and telephone numbers of relatives
  - Name and telephone number of the family doctor
  - If applicable: organ donor card
  - If applicable: living will
